Level 1 Test

All riders must pass a riding test as well as a written test before moving from Level 1 into Level 2. The riding test involves mounting/dismounting properly, correct basic position, reverses performed in trot, trot circles, transitions between walk and trot, correct two-point and vertical far positions and proper halting. The Level 1 written test covers basic horse and stable safety rules, the natural aids and English saddle and bridle parts. The following picture is a study guide for the saddle and bridle parts for the Level 1 written test.
